### Policy Reminders –

\* Please help protect our liquor license! No alcoholic beverages are allowed to be brought on property per Kentucky State Law. All alcoholic beverages must be purchased through the club. We will provide a cooler for your beverages and they can be checked out from the golf shop and bar. Please return coolers at the end of the day.

### *Parking Areas –*

- 1 – Please park automobiles in the designated areas of the parking lot.
- 2 – Please remember the circle area is for drop off only and the concrete beside the kitchen area is not a designated automobile parking area.
- 3 – Please do not park automobiles by the golf cart sheds – they are easy targets for wayward golf balls.

### *Please help protect our golf course by following these basic rules*

- 1 – Keep your golf cart a minimum of 30 yards from all greens.
- 2 – Repair ball marks on the greens.
- 3 - Rake the sand traps.
- 4 – Follow all golf cart restrictions.
- 5 - No more than 2 golf carts per group.
