Policy Reminders –

Underage Golf Cart Drivers

Golf Cart Rules – *In order to drive a golf cart on MGCC property, you must be 16 years old and have a drivers' license or permit, or you must be accompanied by an adult.*

1st Offense Written warning – Parents/Guardians will also be notified

2nd Offense 14 day suspension of golf privileges –

Golf cart is also suspended

Golf cart will not be able to be used at all during time of suspension

3rd Offense 1 month suspension from golf privileges

Golf cart is also suspended

Golf cart will not be able to be used at all during time of suspension

Please help protect our golf course by following these basic rules

1 – Keep your golf cart a minimum of 30 yards from all greens.

2 – Repair ball marks on the greens.

3 - Rake the sand traps.

4 – Follow all golf cart restrictions.
