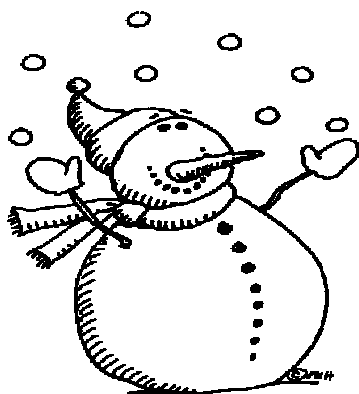

## The Proper Way to Repair a Ball Mark

1. Use a prolonged ball mark repair tool or tee.
2. Insert at the edges of the mark, not the middle of the depression.
3. Bring the edges together with a gentle twisting motion, but don't lift the center. Try not to tear the grass.
4. Smooth the surface with a club or foot. You're done when it's a surface you would putt on.

A fresh ball mark repaired by a player takes only

**FIVE SECONDS**

A freshly repaired ball mark will completely heal in

**TWENTY FOUR HOURS**

A fresh ball mark left unrepaired for only one hour requires

**FIFTEEN DAYS TIME**

Before the ugly scar has satisfactory healed

**PLEASE REPAIR ALL BALL MARKS**
